Dear Neighbours of **Pioneer Avenue**

Please take a moment to read this notice regarding the filming of scenes for a Christmas TV movie for Hallmark that will be in your neighbourhood from **September 12 and 13 , 2022**.

1357697 BC Ltd would like to provide some information to help you prepare for our arrival and anticipate how our activity might affect your daily routine.

The following is an outline of our filming dates, times, locations and significant action:

September 11th: Prep 8:00AM to 8:00PM

- Reduced crew prepares **Pioneer Avenue** between **7098 and 7072** for filming

September 12th: Filming 8:00AM to 8:00PM

- **7:00AM** - Crew will arrive and prepare for a day of filming
- Filming exterior walk and talk scenes between **7098 and 7072 on Pioneer Avenue**
- **8:00PM to 10:00PM** - Trucks get loaded and resume with security presence. Crew leave the neighbourhood quietly.
- **8:00AM to 8:00PM** - Reduced crew prepares **Nations Creations at 6958 Pioneer Avenue** for filming

September 13th: Filming 8:00AM to 8:00PM

- **7:00AM** Crew will arrive and prepare for a day of filming
- Filming interior dialog scenes at **Nations Creations, 6958 Pioneer Avenue**
- **8:00PM to 10:00PM** - Trucks get loaded with equipment and crew leave the neighbourhood quietly
- **8:00AM to 8:00PM** - Reduced crew comes to restore **Pioneer Avenue** to its original condition

September 14th: Wrap 8:00AM to 8:00PM

- Reduced crew comes to restore **Nations Creations, 6958 Pioneer Avenue** to its original condition

In order to minimize our impact on the neighbourhood, we will be parking our crew vehicles and large trucks off site on private property. However we will be using eight parking stalls front of 6958 Pioneer Avenue. Our work does not involve any loud noises or gunfire but there will be snow and Christmas decorations.
