Krypto Films Inc. would like to provide some information to help you prepare for our arrival and anticipate how our activity might affect your daily routine.

The District of Kent, Agassiz has asked that we poll your neighbourhood prior to any filming activity

The following is an outline of our filming dates, times, locations, and significant activity.

September 28 Prep Day - 8:00AM to 8:00PM

Reduced crew prepares 6870 Kalyna Drive for filming

September 29 Filming 3:30PM to 3:30AM

1:30PM - Crew will begin to arrive and prepare for a day of filming
Filming exterior and interior scenes at 6870 Kalyna Drive
2:30AM to 3:30AM – Crew quietly packs gear and there is security presence after crew leave neighbourhood quietly.

September 30 Filming 3:30PM to 3:30AM

2:30PM Crew will begin to arrive and prepare for a day of filming
Filming exterior and interior scenes at 6870 Kalyna Drive
2:30AM to 3:30AM – Crew quietly packs gear into trucks and leave the neighbourhood and there is security presence after crew and all Production vehicles leave neighbourhood quietly.

October 1- Wrap Day - 9:00am to 8:00pm

Reduced crew arrive to reset interior and exterior of 6870 Kalyna Drive

To minimize our impact on the neighbourhood, we will be parking our crew vehicles and large trucks off site on private property. However, we will be using driveway areas for support equipment and generator.

Filming work does not involve any loud noises or gunfire or special stunts.
